

**Suggested questions for interview for new Parish Councillors:**

1. What knowledge do you have about Loose Parish generally?
2. What do you feel you can bring to the Loose Parish Council and to the people of the Parish.
3. If you have been, or are already a Parish Councillor in another Parish, can you share any positive differences you feel you may have made in your local community or elsewhere.
4. How do you see your role as a Loose Parish Councillor?
5. What difference can you make to the Parish and Parish Council in terms of commitment and in sharing your skills and attributes with fellow Councillors?
6. Do you feel you are a team player?
7. Are you committed to taking part in training and personal development in connection with the role of Parish Councillor?
8. Are you prepared to be a member of at least two committees, most of which meet every two months or every two weeks if it is planning committee? Most meetings are held on a Monday evening.
9. Are you prepared for the challenges faced under the Localism Act and in providing a transparent, positive and professional service to the people of Loose?
